FRIDAY

The meeting was called to order by Presbytery Moderator, Ruling Elder Mark Owens at 1:00 PM. There were 16 in person voting member attendees and 24 Zoom voting member attendees. Opening worship was led by Rev. Karl Heimbeck, pastor of the host church, and the message was given by Rev. Monte Reichenberg. Syria-Lebanon Partnership Team Rev. Bob and Holly Garrard reported on the work being done by this group and the needs they have.

Synod Report Rev. Bob Garrard gave the report. Lynn Smit, Synod Stated Clerk, is retiring at the end of the year. Candice Sweet, current Stated Clerk of Utah Presbytery, has been hired as the new Synod Stated Clerk. Red Clay Abby was awarded a \$500 scholarship.

General Assembly Commissioners' Reports were given by RE Trena Wiesshaar and TE Rev. Bruce McBurney. Presbytery will vote on Overtures at its April 2023 meeting.
